PULLOVER/JACKET/SWEATER

HAIRSTYLES AND HEADWEAR	
YES – ALLOWED	NO – NOT ALLOWED
 Most hairstyles are permitted Headbands, hair bows and hair accessories MUST be uniform colors only Headwear worn for religious reasons 	✓ No bandanas of any color or pattern✓ No hats✓ No scarves, bonnets, or durags

ACCESSORIES

Youth-appropriate uniform color bracelets, rings, and ear-wear are permitted (NO facial piercings). The school reserves the right to confiscate and require parent pick-up for accessories that distract or disrupt the learning environment in any way

BACKPACKS

Students may carry clear (see through) backpacks to school and carry them throughout the end of the day.

NOT ALLOWED: solid color-non see through backpacks.
