



## 2023-2024 School Uniform Policy

“The gender neutral, age inclusive dress expectation is that all people’s bellies, backs, shoulders, chest, and bottoms are fully covered while in the school building.”

### *SHOES*

YES - ALLOWED	NO – NOT ALLOWED
Tennis shoes Sandals must be closed toe with a strap on the heel	NO high heels or platforms NO crocs or house shoes NO knee-high or thigh high boots NO flip flops NO slides

### *BOTTOMS*

YES - ALLOWED	NO – NOT ALLOWED
Khaki (Brown) school pants or tan colored <u>ONLY</u> Khaki shorts – knee length only Khaki capris/jumpers – knee length only Khaki Skorts – knee length only *Pants must sit at the waist*	<b>NO BLUE OR BLACK KHAKIS OR JEANS</b> No joggers

### *TOPS*

YES - ALLOWED	NO – NOT ALLOWED
KIPP polo or solid polo (navy blue, orange, white, light blue or gray) Shirt must be tucked in as appropriate for body	No T-shirts or tank tops

### *PULL OVERS*

YES - ALLOWED	NO – NOT ALLOWED
KIPP or navy blue, orange, white, light blue or gray KIPP or navy blue, orange, white, light blue or gray cardigan or sweater	No Hoodies No non-KIPP jackets or sweaters worn during the school day

### *HAIRSTYLES AND HEADBAND*

YES - ALLOWED	NO – NOT ALLOWED
Most hairstyles are permitted Headbands and hair bows – uniform colors preferred Head wear worn for religious reasons	No bandanas of any color pattern No hats worn inside the building No scarves, bonnets or durags worn inside the building

### *ACCESSORIES*

Youth appropriate bracelets, rings and earwear are permitted. The school reserves the right to confiscate and require parent pickup of accessories that distract or disrupt the learning environment.
