SHOES

YES - ALLOWED	NO – NOT ALLOWED
Tennis shoes	NO high heels or platforms

BOTTOMS

YES - ALLOWED	NO – NOT ALLOWED
Khaki (Brown) school pants or tan colored ONLY	NO BLUE OR BLACK KHAKIS OR JEANS
Khaki shorts – knee length only	No joggers
Khaki capris/jumpers - knee length only	
Khaki Skorts – knee length only	
Pants must sit at the waist	

TOPS

YES - ALLOWED	NO – NOT ALLOWED
KIPP polo or solid polo (navy blue, orange, white, light blue or gray)	No T-shirts or tank tops
Shirt must be tucked in as appropriate for body	

PULL OVERS

YES - ALLOWED	NO – NOT ALLOWED
KIPP or navy blue, orange, white, light blue or	No Hoodies
gray KIPP or navy blue, orange, white, light blue or gray cardigan or sweater	No non-KIPP jackets or sweaters worn during the school day

HAIRSTYLES AND HEADBAND
